Susan Stites-Doe is the Dean of Graduate Studies at The College at Brockport, State University of New York (SUNY), which averages 1,500 graduate student enrollments per semester across 19 departments. Stites-Doe also teaches organizational behavior at the college. She joined the faculty in 1994 after serving as an adjunct professor at the campus for several years. Before entering higher education, she worked in industry positions and focused on market development and strategic planning.

Stites-Doe is an active member of the Council of Graduate Schools and presents annually on topics of interest to members of the graduate school community from across the nation. She is on the Board of Directors of ETS's GRE® (*Graduate Record Examinations*®) Board, and also serves on ETS's Board of Directors of the TOEFL® program. She served as a member of the GRE® General Test Technical Advisory Committee for six years.

Her journal publications focus on topics of leadership and acculturation, CEO compensation and the strategic benefits of diversity. Her textbook publications focus on organizational behavior and leadership.

Stites-Doe earned a B.S. in business administration from SUNY Plattsburgh, an MBA in marketing management from Pace University, and a Ph.D. in organizational behavior from the University at Buffalo.
