James C. Wimbush is Dean of The University Graduate School and professor of business administration at Indiana University (IU). The University Graduate School administers master's and doctoral programs, excluding professional programs, on all eight IU campuses. These programs comprise more than 14,800 students, including 7,300 in Bloomington and 5,500 in Indianapolis.

Wimbush has served in multiple administrative positions. These include Chair of the Department of Management and Entrepreneurship in the Kelley School of Business, Chair of the Kelley Doctoral Programs in Business, Chair of the Kelley MBA Program, and Associate Dean of the Faculties for the Bloomington campus. He currently serves as a member of IU President Michael McRobbie's Cabinet.

In addition to his administrative and service duties, Wimbush has received numerous awards for his graduate and undergraduate teaching. Wimbush is also a member of the Board of Directors of the GRE® (*Graduate Record Examinations*®) Board. He is an acknowledged national authority on business ethics as they relate to human resource practices and has published numerous articles in this area.

Wimbush earned his B.S. from Averett College, a master's degree in human resources management and industrial and labor relations, and a Ph.D. in management from Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University.
